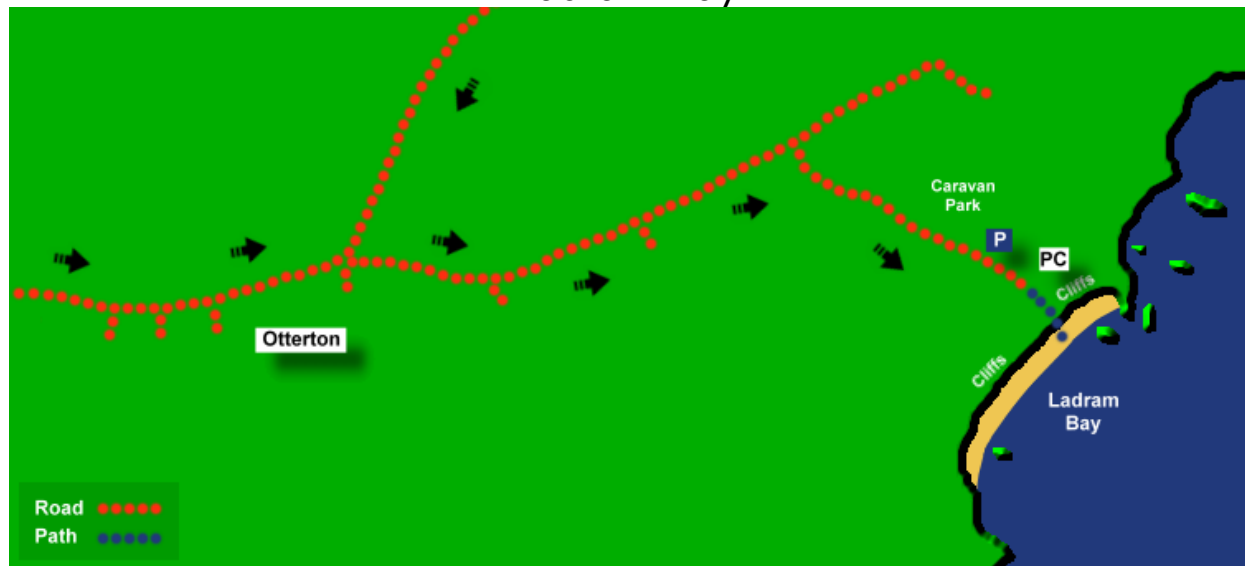


Ladram Bay



- Description: Ladram Bay is a picturesque bay with impressive red cliffs and a long sand and pebble beach. There are plenty of facilities in the caravan park for the public to use such as toilets and cafés, but unfortunately the car park is rather small
- Safety: No details available
- Access: Slipway to the beach
- Dogs: Dogs banned all year
- Directions: Ladram Bay is about 2 miles from Budleigh Salterton which is approximately 17 miles from Exeter. Take the A376 from Exeter. If bypassing Exeter on the M5 turn off onto the A376 (Junction 30, signposted to Exmouth). On the A376 at the roundabout at Clyst St Mary go straight across onto the A3052 (signposted to Sidmouth and Seaton) and continue on the A3052 to Newton Poppleford. At Newton Poppleford, turn right onto the B3178 (signposted to Budleigh Salterton). Continue on the B3178 until the Brick Cross junction and turn left (signposted to Otterton and Ladram Bay). Drive into Otterton village and then turn right where signposted to Ladram Bay. Follow this road out of Otterton and after about a mile turn right where signposted to the Ladram Bay caravan park
- Parking: 1 small car park for the public to use, £2 off peak, £5 peak for all day (2014 prices)
- Toilets: Toilets which can be used by the public are in The Three Rocks Entertainment Complex
- Facilities: Three Rocks Entertainment Complex, Beach Café, Pebbles Bar & Restaurant, Waves Bar, Coast Takeaway
- Activities: Boat hire

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
